Materials list: for working on white paper

- White spiral bound sketch book 6 x 9" or 8.5 x 11"
- Black waterproof ink pens for fine lines, Faber-Castell Pitt (S or F tips)
- several Aquarelle (water soluble) pencils, and a brush with water reservoir.

Optional:

Faber-Castell Pitt pens with B (brush) tips: shades of gray and/or colors
Prismacolor pencils in a few colors (these are NOT water soluble, or erasable)

Materials list: for working on tinted paper

- Gray or tan spiral bound sketch book 6 x 9" or 8.5 x 11"
- Black waterproof ink pens, Faber-Castell Pitt (S or F tips). B tip optional
- White Prismacolor pencil and/or white gel pen.

Materials list: for intermediate/advanced sketchers

- White spiral bound sketch book 6 x 9" or 8.5 x 11"
- Soft graphite pencils: 2B through 5B
- Kneaded eraser
- paper stumps for blending
- pen knife, sandpaper pad

Accessories: pencil sharpener, clear vinyl zipper pouch, bulldog clips
